The crystal structure features of antipinite $KNa_3Cu_2(C_2O_4)_4$, a new oxalate mineral

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A new oxalate mineral antipinite is found in a guano deposit located on the Pabellón de Pica Mountain, Iquique Province, Tarapacá Region, Chile. The new mineral is named in memory of the late scientist Mikhail Yuvenal'evich Antipin (1951-2013), a specialist in the crystallography and crystal chemistry of organoelement and coordination compounds.
